



A brass band which entertained HM The Queen and hit the right note with Grand Prix drivers is to bring its unique blend of music and entertainment to Rhyl.

Bombay Baja – Europe's leading Indian brass band – will headline one of the events planned by Rhyl Town Council over the next few months. The Mayor's May Day (May 9) will bring colour, music and entertainment to the town's High Street all led by the brass band which has performed around the world including at the Bahrain Grand Prix.

Other events and activities include an entertaining walkabout act for Easter, a seasidethemed Sunny Rhyl Summer Sizzler planned for July, and a free children's Christmas party in December. The Summer Sizzler will see Granny Turismo - the world's only shopping trolley dance display team - come to Rhyl for the first time.

Rhyl mayor Cllr Ellie Chard said: "Once again, the town council is providing free entertainment for residents and visitors to the town with events packed with enthralling acts, activities and things to do. We'll have a few 'firsts' but also welcome back some favourites such as Punch 'n' Judy and the amazing Batala Bangor drumming band."

Caricaturists, circus skills workshops, stilt walkers, craft-making and face painters will also be joining this year's line-up.

"The Mayor's May Day will be held over VE Day weekend and have lots of activities and experiences which nod to this historic occasion. We've planned events for all ages with lots of activities people can do together, including the chance for the whole community to create a huge piece of artwork.
